Presentation Instructions

For poster presenters

- (1) Language
- Presentation language is **English only**.

(2) Dimensions

- Common size of poster board is 90cm width and 210cm height.
- To make a poster, A0 size (841mm width and 1,189mm height) is recommended.
- On the poster, **session theme number*** and 3-digit **paper submission number** should be written clearly with the title of paper, authors and their affiliations as shown in the figure attached.
- Pins for mounting will already be prepared along with the board.

* Session theme number

- T1 Impacts of Climate Change on Dams and the Benefits from Dams
- T2 Dams for Meeting Increasing Demand of Growing World Population
- T3 Knowledge & Technology Transfer in Dam Engineering
- T4 Advanced Technologies for Construction of Dams
- T5 New Techniques to Prevent and Manage Incidents & Accidents
- T6 Earthquakes
- T7 Geotechnical Aspects of Dam Foundations

(3) Presentation

- All poster presenters should set up their own poster by themselves after 2:00 pm on June 4 and no later than 8:30 am on June 5.
- Poster boards will be prepared in the **corridor outside the room of the oral session of the corresponding theme.** Set up location for individual presenters will be indicated on the board by session theme number and paper submission number (e.g.T1-001).
- All posters will be displayed throughout the symposium day on June 5.
- The poster session will be held **from 3:10 pm to 4:10 pm on June 5**. All poster presenters should come to their own poster, explain and answer questions.
- All poster presenters who want to bring back their own poster should remove it by themselves no later than **6:30 pm on June 5**. Posters left on the board after the time

will be disposed by the secretariat.

- Poster presenters who want to display their posters after June 5 inform the secretariat in Room 103 no later than **6:30 pm on June 5**. After the permission, the poster presenters should set up their own poster by themselves on the boards same as above to be available on the corridor around the exhibition hall from June 6 to June 8. The poster should be removed no later than 3:00 pm on June 8. Posters left on the board after the time will be disposed by the secretariat.




Figure 1 Dimensions and layout of poster
